The two sometimes tackle the streets as a tandem, so look out. Double trouble some say. They may be coming to a conference or department near you!

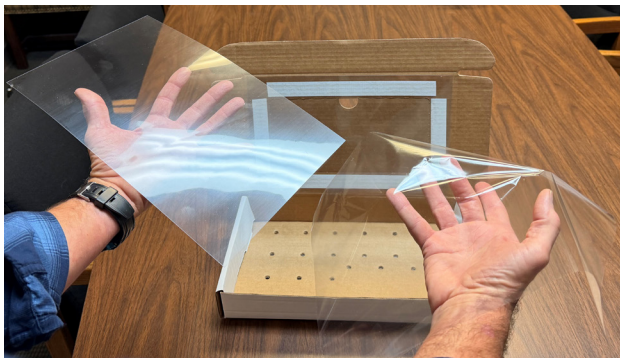

My thought is if it can repair just one marriage. Get someone to give up the bottle. Save a life from suicide. If it can do anything, it’s worth the effort.

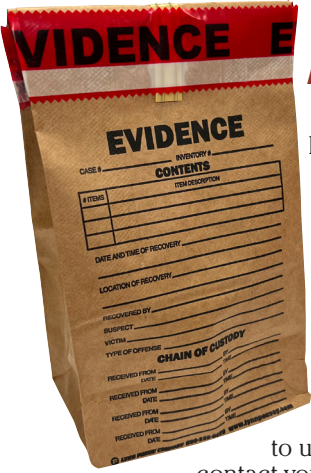
